



DIY CHRISTMAS TREE PHOTO FRAME

If you are looking for a fun and easy craft for your children this holiday why not get them to make a Christmas tree photo frame. It would make a lovely gift for grandparents or a keepsake decoration for years to come.


YOU WILL NEED:

- Lionheart write and colour markers
- Callicreative Italic marker in white
- A4 green card
- Photo
- Empty toilet roll tube
- Glue
- Scissors
- Gem stickers
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Ribbon



Project Time: 30 Minutes Project Level: Beginner







Craft Project



STEP 1

Fold the green card in half and use your ruler to measure how wide it is along the top edge. Draw a dot with your pencil in the centre and then draw two lines from the centre to each bottom corner making a triangle.

STEP 2

Leave the card folded and cut out the triangle so you end up with two identical shapes.



STEP 3


Draw a circle at the bottom of the triangle, this will be for the photo so make sure it will be the right size for your picture.

STEP 4

Cut out the circle then position the frame on your photo.









Craft Project

STEP 5

Draw around the outside of the triangle on the photo and then cut it out. Add glue to the green card around the circle to stick the photo into place.



STEP 7Glue strips of ribbon across the front of the tree.



$\ensuremath{\text{STEP\,9}}$ Use the gem stickers for baubles and extra decoration.



Add more glue to the second triangle all the way around the edges and stick the two pieces together.



STEP 8

Use the black Lionheart marker to draw a twisty string of fairy lights, then add bulbs with the other colour pens and the white Italic marker











STEP 10

Cut the empty toilet roll in half to make the trunk for your tree, then cut two sits half way down the roll in one end making sure they are opposite each other.





STEP 11

Place the tree onto the truck base by sliding it into the slits and now your Photo Christmas Tree is ready to be displayed!
