MINI WAX PUMPKIN

Are you looking for new ideas for your Halloween pumpkins? Do you hate to get your hands dirty scooping out the insides for a jack o' lantern or are you just looking for something a little different? Why don't you have a go at making a colourful mini wax pumpkin?

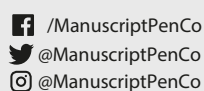
YOU WILL NEED:

- Manuscript Wick Wax in different colours
- Mini pumpkin or squash (white works best)
- Lighter or matches
- Callicreative Flexi Markers
- Scissors
- Newspaper or scrap paper to protect your work surface



Project Time: 30 Minutes

Project Level: Beginner (children will need supervision)



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STEP 1

Place your pumpkin on top of your paper and select your first colour of wax. Hold the sealing wax over the top of your pumpkin and carefully light the wick. Let the wax pool around the stem of the pumpkin and drip down the sides. Be careful with the flame and blow it out and trim the wick with scissors if it gets too long.

STEP 2

Light the next sealing wax and drip it over and around the first colour. You can build up as many colours and layers as you like but we went with a two colour combination.



STEP 3

Allow the wax to dry completely and then use the Callicreative Flexi markers to add some extra decoration to the side of the pumpkin. You can add drips and splashes in complimentary or clashing colours.
