LIONHEART SPOOKY SPIDERS

If you have little hands to keep busy this half term why not try our spooky spider craft to celebrate Halloween?

YOU WILL NEED:

- Lionheart Wooden Pencils - Orange & Green
- Callicreative Marker - Black
- A4 black paper or card x 2
- A4 white paper or card x 1
- Pencil
- Safety scissors
- Glue
- Small cup of water
- A Paintbrush



Project Time: 60 Minutes including drying time
Project Level: Beginner - Perfect for kids



STEP 1

Take a sheet of white A4 paper and draw four intersecting lines with a pencil for the base of your spider's web. Then add strands of web connecting the lines together.

STEP 2

Use the orange and green wooden pencils to colour in alternate sections of the web. This doesn't have to be perfect, you can go over the lines or leave patches of paper showing through.



STEP 3

With either the paintbrush or your finger add a small amount of water to the coloured in web, the pencil will take on a watercolour effect and mix and blend together. Set the paper aside to dry for 20-30 mins.

STEP 4

While the web dries you can make the spider. Take a sheet of black card and draw two circles, one approx 8cm in diameter and the other approx 4cm. These will make the body and head. Cut the circles out with safety scissors and position the smaller circle near the top of the larger one. You can glue them into place once you are happy with the shape.

STEP 5

Draw a spider leg on the black card and cut it out, you can then use this as a template to draw around for the other seven legs. Cut out and position four on each side of the spider's body and then glue them into place.



STEP 6

Once the web has dried take your black callicreative marker and draw over the pencil lines of the web to make them stand out. Then cut out the web carefully and glue it onto the second sheet of black A4 card.



STEP 7

Draw two small circles for the spiders eyes and make them look as spooky as you want! Add pupils and eyelids using the black marker. Cut them out and glue them on the spider's head.



STEP 8

Use your ruler to draw two strips on the leftover black card and cut them out.



STEP 9

Glue the two strips of card into an L shape.

STEP 10

Fold the bottom piece of the card from the right to the left going over the top part of the L shape. Then fold the top piece of the L shape over the bottom piece. Rotate the card until it looks like an L again and then repeat the steps until you have folded all of the card and made a paper spring.



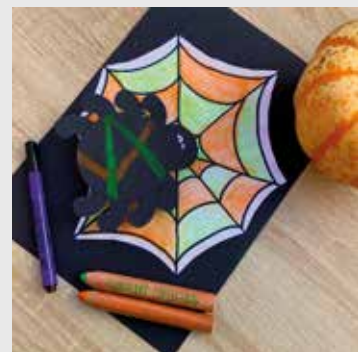
STEP 11

Glue one end of the paper spring to the underside of the spider and the other end onto the spider's web. Your spooky spider will now jiggle in his web if you shake the paper or give him a little push



STEP 12

Use your wooden pencils to draw a pattern on the body of your spider, try to make him look really scary!
