



Father's Day Craft Project

MAKING MEMORIES

This Father's Day why not show your dad how much you care by making him a special card and personalise it with a photo of you together? This craft is suitable for children and adults.

You Will Need


- A pack of Italic Markers metallic
- A Duotip pen (in the colour of your choice)
- A4 card (also in the colour of your choice)
- Scissors
- Plain gift tag
- A short piece of ribbon or twine
- Ruler
- Glue
- A photo of you and your dad

Project time: 30 minutes

Project level: Good for beginners









Step 1

Clear a space on your desk or table, take your sheet of A4 card and place it in the landscape position. Then fold it in half to make your card shape.

Step 2

On your gift tag draw some evenly spaced lines to write on using the fine tip of your Duotip pen and a ruler. Write "Making Memories" on the top of the tag (near the hole) and then record some of your favourite memories of your dad.



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
Step 3

Take your piece of ribbon or twine and fold it in half, insert the loop you have made through the hole in the tag going in from the back of the tag so that the loop pokes out of the side you have written on. Now push the two ends of the ribbon or twine through the middle of the loop and then pull them together gently and upwards until the ribbon/twine is attached to the tag. If you need to, trim the ribbon or twine so both sides are the same length and the ends are nice and neat. Place this to one side while you begin the lettering on your card.

Step 4

Starting near the top on the right hand side of your card use the gold Italic Marker to write the word "Happy". The word "Father's" should go in the centre of your card directly underneath "Happy" and you need to add some loops and flourishes to the letters f, h, r and s. You might want to practice a couple of times on some scrap paper before you do it on the card if you aren't confident when it comes to lettering. Add a loop coming down down from the letter "s" and take it along to the left, then curve it slightly down and to the right. Write the word "Day" next to the end of your loop.







Step 5

Using more of the Italic Markers and your ruler, draw some lines around your Father's Day message, you can choose which colours will go best with your card. This card uses silver, blue and green in groups of three and alternating between the colours so silver, blue, silver, green, silver etc. Start the lines on the left hand side of "Happy Father's Day" near the bottom and work your way around clockwise until you reach the top of the letter "s" of "Father's". You will need the rest of the blank space for your photo and memory tag.

Step 6

Position your photo and tag together on the bottom half of your card. If you need to, trim your photo down so it fits in the space nicely and when you are happy with how it looks glue them both into place.



Once the glue is dry the card is finished and all that is left to do is for you to write your heartfelt message inside!
